Student Loan
Payments to Restart
After **May 1, 2022**



On December 22, 2021, the U.S. Department of Education (ED) extended the student loan payment pause through May 1, 2022.

The pause includes the following relief measures for eligible loans:

- a suspension of loan payments
- a 0% interest rate
- stopped collections on defaulted loans
