Unfortunately, our office does not have grants and/or scholarships to assist with this cost.



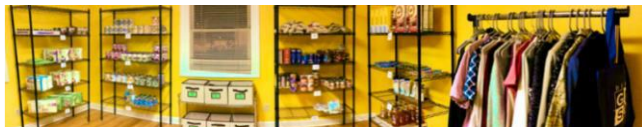
