When can I expect to receive a refund and how do I know what amount I am going to receive?

Financial Aid disburses 10 days prior to the start of each term. Refunds are processed during the first week of class for each term. For the most up to date transactions log into DukeHub, Financials, Account Activity Classic. The transaction that reads "refund – student" add 3 – 5 business day to this date to see the funds in your designated direct deposit account.

Wondering the amount of your refund? Log into DukeHub, Financials, Billing History. Take the last billing statement that shows the total aid that you have accepted.

Total Transactions (tuition/fees) deduct the Total Anticipated Financial Aid = estimated refund
