Leave of Absence

Things to Consider:

What should I do if I'm considering taking a leave of absence?

- ✓ Speak to Advisory Dean or your Program Director
- ✓ Complete Status Change Form (Medical Students)
- ✓ Speak to Financial Aid Office
- ✓ If you have health insurance through Duke, speak to Student Health
 - Medical Leave of Absences (MLOA): Students that go on a medical leave are able to retain their health insurance as long as the health insurance has been charged to the student and paid. Students should contact Student Health to communicate they will be going on a MLOA.
 - Personal Leave of Absences (PLOA): Students that go on a personal leave during the Fall Insurance Enrollment Period of June 15 – September 14, health insurance coverage will be terminated. If the PLOA occurs after September 30th, the student will maintain coverage through December 31st of the same year. If the leave occurs beyond the fall term, coverage would be terminated for spring and summer terms if applicable. If a student goes on PLOA in February, health insurance coverage remains in place through July 31st . Students should be contact Student Health to communicate their leave dates.
- ✓ You should check your Duke email throughout your leave, unless the circumstances of your leave prevent you from doing so.

- ✓ Have you paid for the term you are in?
